1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

**KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)**

Respondent has accepted the summons but refused to sign the same. He is proceeded against ex parte.

Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition bearing HMA No.25/2018, dated 09.01.2018, filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Narinder Singh vs Navdeep Kaur*”, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Moga, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Tarn Taran.

Heard.

It is stated that proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. between parties are pending at Tarn Taran Courts. The petitioner belongs to Tehsil Patti, District Tarn Taran.

The distance between Patti and Moga is about 80 Kms. and between Patti and Tarn Taran is about 35 Kms. Therefore, mere pendency of one case under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is not sufficient ground to transfer the aforesaid case from Moga Courts to Tarn Taran Courts.

As such, the present petition is dismissed.

However, it is directed that when the petitioner appears in person at Moga Courts, to pursue her case, the respondent will pay ₹2,000/- as travelling expenses for each visit.
