Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Raghvir Singh vs Manpreet Kaur*”, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Malout, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Faridkot.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that it is difficult for the petitioner to pursue her case at Malout. A case under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, is already pending at Faridkot Courts.

Considering the difficulty expressed by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Raghvir Singh vs Manpreet Kaur*”, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Malout, is withdrawn from the said

Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court,
Faridkot.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
