Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been filed by the respondent before learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kharar. Petitioner belongs to Phillaur, District Jalandhar. The distance between Phillaur and Kharar is about 116 kms. She is unable to pursue her case at Kharar.

Keeping in view the difficulty expressed by the petitioner, petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending before learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kharar is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jalandhar.

Petition is allowed accordingly.
