KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as **“Rajiv Kumar versus Sonia Rani”** pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Kurukshetra to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Yamunanagar at Jagadhari.

Heard.

It comes out that there is a distance of only 45 KMs between Kurukshetra to Yamunanagar. Further, the village (Khajuri) of the petitioner is situated between Yamunanagar and Kurukshetra and the same is few kilometers from Kurukshetra which has further reduced the distance. Therefore, in any way the petitioner is either go to Yamunanagar, Jagadhari or to Kurukshetra.

No ground is made out to transfer the petition from Kurukshetra to Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari.

Dismissed.
