This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code, 1908 for transfer of the petition titled as '**Raman Kumar vs. Minakshi**' filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge, (Senior Division), Patti to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Amritsar.

It is stated that one case is already pending in the Court at Amritsar and it is very difficult for the petitioner to go from Majithia to Patti on each and every date of hearing to pursue her case. Therefore, it is requested that all the cases should be tried at one place.
