KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in case No. HMA/468/2017 dated 13.12.2017 titled as **“Dr. Anshul Garg versus Dr. Niharika Goyal”** pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Barnala to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petition is seeking transfer of the case on the ground that the presiding officer is the family friend of the respondent.

Both the counsel have agreed that the case may be transferred to Sangrur Courts which is convenient to both the parties.

In view of above, the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in case No. HMA/468/2017 dated 13.12.2017 titled as **“Dr. Anshul Garg versus Dr. Niharika Goyal”** pending in the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Barnala is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Sangrur, who shall retain the case herself.

In view of above, petition stands allowed. Both the parties are directed to appear before the Court of learned District Judge, Sangrur on 23.5.2018 at 10 A.M.

Since the main petition is allowed, the miscellaneous application pending, if any, also stands disposed of.
