Kuldeep Singh, J. (Oral)

Respondent served but not present. Therefore, he is proceeded against ex-parte.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Navjot Singh vs. Navneet Kaur* pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Patiala.

It comes out that a petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 is already pending at Amritsar Courts. Minor child of the parties is residing with the father at Amritsar. Parties last resided at Amritsar. Witnesses also belong to Amritsar.

Therefore, considering the entirety of circumstances, there is no ground to transfer the case from Amritsar Courts to Patiala Courts.

Resultantly, the present petition stands dismissed.
