Petitioner seeks transfer of Civil Suit no.408 of 2017 filed by respondent no.1 titled as *Harwinder Singh vs. Sharanjit Kaur and another* from the Court of Shri Ravipal Singh, learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Phillaur, District Jalandhar to any Court of competent jurisdiction at SBS Nagar (Nawanshehar) or any other District except Phillaur, Phagwara, Chandigarh, Jalandhar and Kapurthala.

It comes out that the petitioner had already filed an affidavit that she will not visit the Bar Associations of Phillaur, Phagwara, Chandigarh, Jalandhar and Kapurthala, which is reflected in the order dated 16.8.2016 (Annexure P7) passed by the Apex Court in Special Leave to Appeal (Criminal) NO.10395 of 2014. She has also stated that she is not having good relations with the Bar Association and nobody is willing to appear on her behalf. The Bar Association Phagwara has already observed

strike on account of some allegations levelled against her. She has also alleged to have scuffle with Harminder Syal, Advocate Phagwara regarding which a criminal case was registered against her.

In the circumstances, Civil Suit no.408 of 2017 filed by respondent no.1 titled as *Harwinder Singh vs. Sharanjit Kaur and another* pending in the Court of Shri Ravipal Singh, learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Phillaur, District Jalandhar is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Ludhiana.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
