Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that two FIR cases as well one case under the Protection of Women from **Domestic Violence Act**, 2005 are already pending at Ludhiana Courts. It is further stated that the respondent is working as SDO at Sahnewal, District Ludhiana. Therefore, prayer is for transfer of petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Gurmanpreet Singh vs. Harpreet Kaur* pending before the Court of District Judge, Patiala to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Ludhiana.

Respondent has not appeared despite service.

Considering that three other cases between the parties are pending at Ludhiana Courts, petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Gurmanpreet Singh vs. Harpreet Kaur* pending before the Court of District Judge, Patiala is

withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to the Court of District Judge, Ludhiana, who may retain the same himself or entrust it to the Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
