TA 205-2018 (O&M)

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 13(1) (i-a) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as Bhanu Grover vs. *Narinder Kaur* pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Ropar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Chandigarh.

It comes out that three cases between the parties are already pending. One is at Chandigarh, one is at Ropar and one is at Nangal.

Petitioner in the present petition has given her Chandigarh address, whereas

in the FIR lodged on 17.2.2018 at Nangal, she has mentioned herself as a resident of Nangal. Moreover, there is not much distance between Chandigarh and Ropar.

In the circumstances, there is no ground to transfer the petition from Ropar Courts to Chandigarh Courts.

Resultantly, the present transfer petition stands dismissed.
