Harinder Singh Sidhu, J. :

The petitioner-wife has filed the present application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of the case titled as “Tarandeep Sawhney vs. Darshpuneet Kaur” filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') by the respondent-husband, pending in the Court of Ld. Additional District Judge, Chandigarh, to District Jalandhar.

It is stated that marriage between the parties was solemnised on 13.11.2016. There is no child born from this wedlock. It is stated that the petitioner is residing at Jalandhar with her old parents. She has no source of income and it is difficult for her to attend the Court at Chandigarh, which is at a distance of about 150 kilometers from her place of residence.

Mr.Bhrigu Dutt Sharma, Advocate appears for the respondent – husband and states that he has no objection if the case is transferred from Chandigarh to Jalandhar.

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Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this petition is allowed. The case bearing No.HMA/49/2018 titled as “Tarandeep Sawhney vs. Darshpuneet Kaur” under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') filed by the respondent-husband, which is presently pending in the Court of Ld. Additional District Judge, Chandigarh is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to District Jalandhar. The District Judge, Jalandhar may assign it to any competent Court at Jalandhar.
