Respondent has been served but none has come present.

Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition bearing No.HMA/2/2018, filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***“Bhupinder Pal Sharma vs Amandeep Kaur”***, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Mansa to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Sangrur.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that two cases, one under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and another under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 between the parties are pending at Sangrur Courts.

In order to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties are tried at one place and the fact that none has come present to oppose the petition, the petition bearing No.HMA/2/2018, filed under Section 9 of the

Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “***Bhupinder Pal Sharma vs Amandeep Kaur***”, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Mansa, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Sangrur, who may try the case himself or entrust the same to a competent Court.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
