Petitioner seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Gautam Dalal vs. Jyoti* pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court), Sonapat to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Rohtak.

It is contended that the petitioner is a HIV patient and getting treatment since 2015 from PGIMS Rohtak. Therefore, she cannot travel to Sonapat Courts to pursue her case. Two other cases between the parties are already pending at Rohtak Courts.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner, petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Gautam Dalal vs. Jyoti* pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court), Sonapat is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court), Rohtak for disposal in accordance with law.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
