Petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending in the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Barnala to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Sangrur.

It is stated that the petitioner is suffering from backache. She has eight years old child.

I am of the view that backache problem at young age of 27 years is always temporary. Now, there is four lane road between Sangrur and Barnala and there is not much difficulty in going either from Sangrur to Barnala or from Barnala to Sangrur. There is no ground to transfer the petition.

Resultantly, the present transfer petition stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been dismissed, therefore, the pending CM, if any, also stands disposed of.
