Applicant-Shivani Sharma presently residing with her parents has filed the instant application seeking transfer of divorce petition moved by her husband-Lalit Sharma against her which is pending in the court of District Judge, Family Court, Gurugram to the court of competent jurisdiction at Palwal. According to her, there is a distance of about 60 km between Palwal and Gurugram and she being a lady, it is difficult for her to go to Gurugram to attend the dates of hearing there more particularly when there is no adult member in the family to company her as parents are of old age. It is further contended that 3 more cases between the parties are pending in various courts at Palwal. Therefore, the present case be also transfer to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Palwal.

Notice of the application was given to respondent who has put in appearance through his counsel.

The request of the applicant is being opposed on behalf of the respondent.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties and going through the record, I find that there are sufficient grounds to accept the application and to transfer the divorce petition presently pending before District Judge Family Court, Gurugram, to court of District Judge, Palwal. It is ordered accordingly. The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before learned District Judge, Palwal on 14.01.2019.

Learned District Judge, Palwal, may keep the petition on his own board or transfer to any other court of competent jurisdiction at Palwal.

Copies of order be sent to to the court concerned for further action.
