Respondent duly served through brother but not present.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing HMA No.896/2017 filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Nitesh Kumar vs. Vaishnavi* pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court) Karnal to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Faridabad.

It is stated that the petitioner has got a minor child. Three cases between the parties are already pending at Faridabad Courts.

Therefore, in order to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties are decided at one place and the fact that none has come present to oppose the petition, petition bearing HMA No.896/2017 filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Nitesh*

Kumar vs. Vaishnavi pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court) Karnal is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned District Judge, Faridabad, who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
