Heard. Petitioner seeks transfer of petition i.e. HMA No. 268 of 2017, titled as *Sukhbinder Singh Bhogal Versus Rajwinder Kaur Sembhi*, filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Kapurthala, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at SBS Nagar (Nawanshahr). It is stated that two other cases are pending at SBS Nagar (Nawanshahr) Courts. It is difficult for petitioner to go from SBS Nagar (Nawanshahr) to Kapurthala to pursue the case. Respondent otherwise belongs to Phagwara which is not at much distance from SBS Nagar (Nawanshahr).

Considering the said fact, petition i.e. HMA No. 268 of 2017, titled as *Sukhbinder Singh Bhogal Versus Rajwinder Kaur Sembhi*, filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Kapurthala, is withdrawn from the said

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Court and same is transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, SBS Nagar (Nawanshahr), who may retain the case with him or entrust the same to a Court of competent jurisdiction. Consequently, petition is allowed. Since main petition has been allowed, therefore, pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
