The petitioner-wife has filed this petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transferring the petition under Section 8 and 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act titled as “Aman Kaushal Vs. Anil Kaushal and others”, which is pending in the Court of Ld. Guardian Judge, Amritsar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Kapurthala.

The marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with the respondent on 02.02.2004. Two male children, namely, Jakash Kaushal and Saiyam Kaushal were born to them, who are presently in care and custody of the respondent. Due to differences between the parties, the petitioner was forced to leave the matrimonial home. She is presently residing at Phagwara, District Kapurthala with her parents. It is difficult for her to attend the Court proceedings at Amritsar. It is stated that respondent is residing at Kapurthala and it would be convenient for him as well if the case is transferred to Kapurthala

Learned counsel for the parties are agreed that the case may be transferred from Amritsar to Kapurthala.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed.

The petition under Section 8 and 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act titled as “Aman Kaushal Vs. Anil Kaushal and others”, which is pending in the Court of Ld. Guardian Judge, Amritsar is withdrawn from that Court and transferred to Kapurthala. The District Judge, Kapurthala may assign it to any competent Court.
