Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 13(i) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as “*Hemant Lakhera vs Kamini*” pending in the Court of learned Addl. District Judge, Rewari to a court of competent jurisdiction at Panipat.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that three other cases between the parties are pending at District Courts, Panipat. Petitioner is an unemployed lady and unable to attend the hearing at District Courts, Rewari.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner, petition filed under Section 13(i) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as “*Hemant Lakhera vs Kamini*” pending in the Court of learned Addl.

District Judge, Rewari is withdrawn from the said court and transferred to the court of learned District Judge, Panipat, who may retain the case himself or entrust it to a court of competent jurisdiction.

As such, present petition is allowed.
