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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Respondent has not appeared, despite service through mother.

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that other litigations are pending between the parties in Ludhiana Courts. Petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as *Gagandeep Singh Chahal Versus Geetika Kapoor*, was filed by respondent husband at Jalandhar Courts after institution of cases by present petitioner at Ludhiana Courts. Request is for transfer of said petition to Ludhiana Courts.

It is deemed proper that all the litigations between the parties should be decided at one place. Accordingly, petition filed by respondent husband under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as *Gagandeep Singh Chahal Versus Geetika Kapoor*, pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jalandhar, is withdrawn from said Court and same is transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Ludhiana, who may try the case himself or entrust it to Court of competent jurisdiction.

Instant petition is allowed.
