KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 (1) (i-a) & (i-b) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in case No. HMA/592/2017 titled as **“Gurpreet Singh versus Jaspreet Kaur”** pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Chandigarh to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that two cases between the parties are already pending at Ludhiana Courts and respondent is appearing in both the cases and it is very difficult for her to travel from Ludhiana to Chandigarh Courts to pursue her case.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent has argued that earlier a compromise was effected between the parties under which a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 was to be filed. Now the petitioner has back out from the said compromise.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner and in order to ensure that all the cases between the parties should be tried at one place, the petition filed under Section 13 (1) (i-a) & (i-b) titled as **“Gurpreet Singh versus Jaspreet Kaur”** pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Chandigarh is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Ludhiana, who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other Court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

In view of above, petition stands allowed.
