As per report received from Mediation and Conciliation Centre, mediation has failed between the parties.

Heard.

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code, 1908 for transfer of petition titled as '***Bhupender Kumar vs. Kaveri Chauhan***' filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kaithal, Haryana to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has one minor daughter who is residing with her. He further submits that respondent-Bhupender Kumar belongs to Village Pharal, Tehsil Dhand, District Kaithal and the distance from the said village to Kaithal and Karnal is almost equal. Therefore, it is requested that all the cases should be tried at

one place.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petition titled as '*Bhupender Kumar vs. Kaveri Chauhan*' filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kaithal, Haryana is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Karnal, who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

In view of above, petition stands allowed.
