Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing no.DMC/320/2017 filed under Section 11 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Dharinder Kumar vs. Kavita Verma* pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge-7, Patiala to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that already four cases between the parties are pending at Bhiwani Courts, out of which, one case under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the wife. Though pendency of the other three cases is disputed. But the fact remains that wife is seeking divorce under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 which is pending at Bhiwani Court and the husband is seeking nullity of marriage under Section 11 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 which is pending at Patiala

Courts. Both the said cases should be tried at one place.

Considering the fact that at least two cases already pending between the parties at Bhiwani Courts, petition bearing no.DMC/320/2017 filed under Section 11 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Dharinder Kumar vs. Kavita Verma* pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge-7, Patiala is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned District Judge, Bhiwani, which shall be entrusted to the same Court where divorce petition filed by the wife is pending.

Both the parties are directed to appear before learned District Judge, Bhiwani on 11.7.2018.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.

Since the main case has been allowed, therefore, the pending CM, if any, also stands disposed of.
