Respondent has put in appearance.

Both the parties have been heard.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing HMA No.308 of 2015 filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Zoraver Singh Bundhel vs. Akanksha Sharma* pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court), Chandigarh to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Gurugram.

It comes out that in the earlier round of transfer applications, transfer application was dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that now there is change in the circumstances as some suits are being filed by her in-laws family.

I am of the view that so far as this divorce petition is

concerned, in the earlier round of litigation, this Court as well as Hon'ble Supreme Court refused to transfer the case from Chadigarh to Gurugram. Mere filing of fresh suits at Chandigarh is no ground to transfer the petition from Chandigarh to Gurugram.

Resultantly, the present transfer petition stands dismissed.
