Petitioner seeks transfer of Civil Suit bearing no. CS CJ 107 of 2017 titled as *Shabnam Singh vs. Akanksha Sharma* pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Gurugram.

The suit is for recovery of damages. The plaintiff in the said case is mother-in-law of the present petitioner. One petition for divorce between the petitioner and her husband is already pending at Chandigarh Courts. In the suit, some allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner. The convenience of the witnesses is also to be seen.
