KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks transfer of a claim petition No.MACT-47 of 2017, filed under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, titled as ***“Surinder Kumar vs Ghansham Dass Gupta and another”***, pending in the Court of learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Faridkot, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Bathinda.

It is claimed that three other claim petitions arising out of the same accident are pending at District Courts, Bathinda. The claim petition filed by the respondent Surinder Kumar is pending at District Courts at Faridkot.

This Court is also informed that the said claim petition is pending for the evidence of the respondents.

I am of the view that the said claim petition is almost mature and it should be sought to be transferred at the earlier stage. Therefore, there is no ground to transfer the aforesaid claim petition at this stage.

As such, the present petition is dismissed. Since, the main petition has been dismissed, therefore, the pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
