Petitioner has filed the present transfer application/petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of the petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled Sukhpal Singh v. Manjeet Kaur @ Rimpi Rani which is pending before learned Additional District Judge Sirsa to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Bathinda.

The ground taken is that the applicant is now residing with her parents with two minor children in Bathinda and Sirsa is 100 km away from Bathinda. She has no source of income and therefore it is very difficult for her to travel.

Counsel for the respondent states that he has no objection if the petition is allowed. In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and

petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled Sukhpal Singh v. Manjeet Kaur @ Rimpi Rani which is pending before learned Additional District Judge, Sirsa is withdrawn from that Court and is transferred to the Family Court, Bathinda.

Let the record be sent there. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before Family Court on 20.12.2018.
