**KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)**

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as **“Vikas versus Komal”** pending in the Court of District Judge/Family Court, Karnal to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Hisar.

On the last date of hearing, respondent had put in appearance and sought time to file reply. Today, no representation has been made on his behalf nor any reply is filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that two cases between the parties are already pending at Hisar Courts and it is difficult for her to travel from Hisar to pursue her case at Karnal Courts.

Keeping in view the distance between the two places; considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner and in order to ensure that all the cases should be tried at one place and the fact that nobody has come present to oppose the petition, petition filed under Section under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as **“Vikas versus Komal”** pending in the Court of District Judge/Family Court, Karnal is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Hisar, who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other Court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

In view of above, petition stands allowed.
