KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Respondent has been served but no representation has been made on behalf of respondent. Hence, proceeded against ex-parte.

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as **“Rajiv Kapoor versus Anju Bala”** pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Ferozepur to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Hoshiarpur (Punjab).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a petition filed under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is already pending between the parties at Hoshiarpur Courts and the distance between Hoshiarpur to Ferozepur is approximately 200 KMs.

Considering the distance between two places; the fact that none has appeared to oppose the petition and in order to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties should be tried at one place, petition filed under Section 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as **“Rajiv Kapoor versus Anju Bala”** pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Ferozepur is

withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Hoshiarpur, who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other Court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

In view of above, petition stands allowed.
