This transfer application has been filed by the applicant-wife to transfer a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act filed by the respondent from the District Court, Patiala to a competent Court at Panchkula on the ground that the marriage was solemnized at Panchkula and she is residing in Panchkula as well and that the distance between Panchkula to Patiala is 63 Kms.

Counsel for the respondent argues that the distance between Panchkula and Patiala is not so much that would cause inconvenience to the applicant. In my opinion, this argument cuts both ways. If this would not harass the applicant then it would also not harass the respondent if he comes to Panchkula to attend the Court proceedings.

In the circumstances, the petition is transferred to the Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Panchkula. The record be sent to the said Court. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before the said Court on

27.12.2018.

Consequently, the transfer application stands allowed in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
