Petitioner seeks transfer of divorce petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the respondent titled as *Gursewak Singh vs. Gurpreet Kaur* pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar to District Court, Tarn Taran.

Heard.

It comes out that earlier husband -respondent has filed a petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 at Tarn Taran Court giving his address as village Jaurah, Tehsil and District Tarn Taran. Now, he has filed a divorce petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 at Amritsar Court giving his address as Village Pandori Mehma, District Amritsar. Another case under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is already pending at Tarn Taran Court.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, divorce

petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the respondent titled as *Gursewak Singh vs. Gurpreet Kaur* pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned District Judge, Tarn Taran, who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
