KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

As per office report, notice issued to respondent has been received back with report '*disowned*'. No representation has been made on behalf of respondent also. Hence, service of respondent is dispensed with.

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in case No. HMA/2086/2016 titled as **“Harpreet Singh versus Geeta Rani @ Soni”** pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Ludhiana exercising the powers of learned District Judge, Ludhiana to the Court of learned District Judge, (Family Court) at Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has filed a petition under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for

grant of maintenance before the learned District Judge (Family Court), Faridkot and she is unable to travel from Kotkapura, District Faridkot to Ludhiana to pursue her case.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner, petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in case No. HMA/2086/2016 titled as **“Harpreet Singh versus Geeta Rani @ Soni”** pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Ludhiana is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Faridkot, who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other Court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

In view of above, petition stands allowed.
