Respondent has not appeared despite service.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing HMA-218/2017 filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as Varinder Kumar @ Gori vs. Garima Kandal pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jalandhar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that three other cases between the parties are already pending at Chandigarh Courts. The present petition has been filed just to harass the petitioner. It is difficult for the petitioner to go to Jalandhar to pursue the present case.

Considering the fact that respondent has not appeared to oppose the present petition and the fact that three other cases between the parties are already pending at Chandigarh Courts, in order to ensure that all the

cases pending between the parties are tried at one place, present petition bearing HMA-218/2017 filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as Varinder Kumar @ Gori vs. *Garima Kandal* pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jalandhar is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Chandigarh, who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
