Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing no.HMA 101 of 2018 filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Tejbir Singh vs. Baljit Kaur* pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Tarn Taran.

Petitioner claims that he belongs to village Bharowal, which is only at the distance of 10 kms. from Tarn Taran.

I am of the view that distance between Tarn Taran and Amritsar is only 25 kms. Therefore, just for the convenience of the petitioner, case cannot be shifted from Amritsar Courts to Tarn Taran Courts.

Resultantly, the present transfer petition stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been dismissed, therefore, the pending CM, if any, also stands disposed of.
