Petitioner seeks transfer of petition i.e. HMA No. 1965 of 2017, titled as *Navdeep Singh Versus Amandeep Kaur*, filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Family Court, Amritsar, to the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for respondent has stated that he has no objection if the petition i.e. HMA No. 1965 of 2017, titled as *Navdeep Singh Versus Amandeep Kaur*, filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Family Court, Amritsar, is transferred to Kapurthala Courts.
