Reply on behalf of the respondent has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition bearing No.HMA 910/2017, filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***“Rohit Khattar vs Bhawna Khattar”***, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Gurgaon, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Mohali.

It is stated that the petitioner is residing at Zirkipur, District Mohali. Respondent is working in New Delhi. He filed the divorce petition at Gurgaon Courts. Petitioner has got a six years old daughter, who is suffering from allergy. Therefore, she cannot go to a far away place like Gurgaon to pursue her case.

The illness of the daughter of the petitioner is not denied by the respondent, who has placed on file some documents to show that she is being treated at New Delhi.

Considering the fact the the daughter of the petitioner, who is suffering from allergy, is living with her mother at Zirkipur and it is difficult for her to travel from Zirkipur to Gurgaon Courts to pursue her case, it is deemed proper that the aforesaid petition be transferred to a mutually convenient place to the parties. Therefore, the petition bearing No.HMA 910/2017, filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***“Rohit Khattar vs Bhawna Khattar”***, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Gurgaon, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Ambala, who may try the case himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
