1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?
2. To be referred to the Reporter or not.

KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Respondents have been served but not present.

Learned counsel for the petitioner-wife contends that petitioner is residing in Village Singhpura, Police Station Kot-Ise-Khan. The respondent-husband has filed a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Gursewak Singh vs Pritpal Kaur and another*”, which is pending in the court of learned District Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib. Learned counsel for the petitioner-wife seeks transfer of the same to a court of competent jurisdiction at Moga.

It is stated that petitioner has a minor son. The distance between Kot-Ise-Khan and Sri Muktsar Sahib is approximately 100 Kms., whereas the distance between Kot-Ise-Khan and Moga is approximately 16 Kms. Another case filed under Section 125 Cr.P.c. is pending at District Courts at Moga.

In view of the matter, the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Gursewak Singh vs Pritpal Kaur and another*”, pending in the court of learned District Judge,

Sri Muktsar Sahib is withdrawn from the said court and transferred to the court of learned District Judge, Moga, who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
