However, except presence of husband of plaintiff-respondent at the time of spot inspection conducted by police, there is no other instance of interference by said Judicial Officer in the working of police or of the Judicial Officer. If any judicial order is passed one way or the other, the other opposite party always has a right of appeal/revision. The gradation list of Judicial Officers in the State of Punjab shows that said Judicial Officer is due for transfer in the month of March/April this year and he is likely to be posted away from District Gurdaspur. The mere fact that husband of plaintiff-respondent is working at a distance of 40 kilometers away from disputed property itself is no ground to transfer the suit. The Judicial Officers can be transferred anywhere in the State of Punjab, and, therefore, if the case is transferred to any other competent Court outside Hoshiarpur Courts, the similar ground will still exist at the said place. No ground to transfer the said suit to any other competent Court outside Hoshiarpur Courts is made out. Therefore, instant civil petition is dismissed.
