The petitioner(wife) has filed this transfer application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled 'Sukhwinder Ram @ Binder vs. Veerpal Kaur', filed by the respondent(husband), which is presently pending before learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mansa to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Moonak (District Sangrur).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the marriage of the petitioner with the respondent was solemnized on 07.05.2014. It is the case of the petitioner that the petitioner was turned out from her matrimonial home on 30.06.2016 and now she is residing with her parents, who are aged. The petitioner has two minor sons aged about 4 and 3 years, who are residing with her. The father of the petitioner, aged 62 years, is suffering from diabetic disease. In these circumstances, it is difficult for the petitioner to attend the Court proceedings at Mansa, which is at a distance of 70 Kms from her residence.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed. The case under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled 'Sukhwinder Ram @ Binder vs. Veerpal Kaur', filed by the respondent(husband), which is presently pending before learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mansa is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to Moonak, District Sangrur. The District Judge, Sangrur may assign it to any competent Court.
