Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Kulvir Singh vs Harpreet Kaur*”, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Tohana to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Bathinda.

Heard.

It is stated that in view of the distance from Bathinda to Tohana, it is very difficult for the petitioner to pursue her case at Tohana Courts.

Respondent has not appeared despite service.

Considering the difficulty expressed by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Kulvir Singh vs Harpreet Kaur*”, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Tohana, is withdrawn from the said

Court and transferred to the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Bathinda, who may retain the case himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
