Petitioner seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***“Harjinder Singh vs Gagandeep Kaur”***, pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Mansa, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Patiala.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had filed a petition under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and as counter blast, the respondent has filed the present petition. It is difficult for the petitioner to travel from Patiala to Mansa Courts to pursue her case.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent states that there is possibility of compromise between the parties. Therefore, the matter may be sent to the Mediation Centre.

Considering the entirety of facts and circumstances, the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***“Harjinder***

Singh vs Gagandeep Kaur”, pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Mansa, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Patiala, who shall try the case himself and before proceeding further, refer the case to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
