Petitioner seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Nitin Gupta vs. Nisha Gupta* pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Patiala to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has got a 9 years old daughter. The distance between two places is around 200 kms. She cannot go Patiala Courts to pursue her case.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner, petition filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Nitin Gupta vs. Nisha Gupta* pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Patiala is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned District Judge, (Family Court), Faridkot who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
