This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code, 1908 for transfer of petition titled as '**Naveen Kumar versus Shiksha**' filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge Family Court, Sonapat to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Jind, Haryana.
