For the reasons mentioned in the application, reply to the transfer application is taken on record.

**TA-900-2017**

This is the petition filed under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code for transfer of the petition titled as *Harjeet Singh versus Kanwaljeet Kaur (Annexure P/1)* filed by respondent against petitioner under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Addl. District and Sessions Judge, Karnal to District Court, Kurukshetra.

It comes out that petitioner belongs to village Rohti, Tehsil Pehowa, District Kurukshetra, whereas respondent belongs to village Bhadson, Tehsil Nilokheri, District Karnal. It is further submitted that said Tehsil Nilokheri is in the middle of Kurukshetra and Karnal. Therefore, convenience of both the parties is that the case should be tried at Kurukshetra.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petition titled as *Harjeet Singh versus Kanwaljeet Kaur (Annexure P/1)*, filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Addl. District and Sessions Judge, Karnal is withdrawn from the said court and transferred to the court of District and Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra, who may retain the case with himself or entrust it to any other court for trial.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
