Petitioner has filed the present transfer application/petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled Sandeep Jain vs. Priyanka which is pending in the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Hisar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Bhiwani.

Counsel for the respondent has very fairly stated that respondent is very keen that the matter be amicably settled and for this reason he would not oppose the prayer for transfer and prays that matter should be send to mediation centre for the purpose of settlement. Counsel for the applicant has accepted this. In the circumstances, the application is allowed. The petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled Sandeep Jain vs. Priyanka which is pending in the Court of

District Judge, Family Court Hisar is withdrawn from that Court and is transferred to Family Court, Bhiwani.

Let the record be sent there. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before the Family Court, Bhiwani on 17.12.2018. In view of the request made by the counsel for the respondent, Family Court, Bhiwani would refer the matter to Mediation Centre, Bhiwani in the first instance.

The application stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
