KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the civil suit filed by respondent titled as **“Suridner Pal versus Jenus and others”**, from the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mansa to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Patiala.

Heard.

It comes out that father-in-law of the petitioner filed a civil suit for permanent injunction against the petitioners and some others restraining them from forcibly entering his house with the help of police.

I am of the view that since the subject matter i.e., house is situated at Mansa, therefore, it will be more convenient for the local Court to enforce the orders that may be passed in the said case. If the applicants-petitioners do not want to enter the house, they are always at liberty to make appropriate statement/representation before the said Court.

No ground to transfer the civil suit filed by respondent titled as “*Suridner Pal versus Jenus and others*”, from the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mansa to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Patiala is made out.

Dismissed.
