Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing no.DMC/30/2017 filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Om Parkash vs. Krishana Devi* pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Rewari to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Chandigarh.

Petitioner is aged about 57 years. The only ground mentioned in the petition is the distance between Chandigarh and Rewari.

I am of the view that the distance itself is no ground to transfer the case from Rewari Courts to Chandigarh Courts, particularly when the witnesses belong to Rewari. Petitioner is not required to appear in person on each and every date of hearing. Convenience of the witnesses is also to be seen. Therefore, there is no ground to transfer the case from Rewari Courts

to Chandigarh Courts.

Present petition is dismissed accordingly.

However, it is directed that whenever petitioner appears in person before Rewari Court, respondent will pay her Rs.5000/- as travelling, boarding and lodging expenses on each date.
