Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

Respondent has not appeared despite service. He is proceeded against ex-parte.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing no.HMA 13 of 2017 filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Prince Singh vs. Rekha* pending before the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Khadoor Sahib, District Tarn Taran to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner belongs to Fatehgarh Churian, District Amritsar, which is at the distance of 70 kms. from Khadoor Sahib. She has to change the buses as such, she is unable to pursue her case at Khadoor Sahib.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner and the fact that the respondent has not come present to oppose the present petition,

petition bearing no.HMA 13 of 2017 filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Prince Singh vs. Rekha* pending before the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Khadoor Sahib, District Tarn Taran is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Amritsar, who may retain the same himself or entrust it to the Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
