Reply not filed. Request for time to file reply is declined.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition for dissolution of marriage under the Mohammedan Law bearing no.DMC/1/2017 filed by the respondent titled as *Sudhir Ahmed v. Sushma and another* pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Family Court, Kurukshetra to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that two cases between the parties are already pending at Sonapat Courts. Petitioner is unable to pursue her case at Kurukshetra Courts.

On the other hand, learned counsel for respondents has opposed the transfer of petition to Sonapat Courts stating that respondent no.2, against whom he has levelled some allegations, is also residing there.

I am of the view that there is no real threat from respondent

no.2. Since, two other cases between the parties are already pending at Sonapat Courts, therefore, petition for dissolution of marriage under the Mohammedan Law bearing no.DMC/1/2017 filed by the respondent as titled as *Sudhir Ahmed v. Sushma and another* pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Family Court, Kurukshetra is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned District Judge, Sonapat, who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.

Since the present petition has been disposed of, therefore, the pending CM, if any, also stands disposed of.
