Petitioner seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as *Surinder Singh Versus Darshan Kaur*, from the Court of learned District Judge, Ludhiana, to District Courts, Moga.

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that three other cases are already pending at Moga Courts.

Considering the difficulty expressed by petitioner and in order to ensure that all cases pending between the parties are decided at one place, divorce petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as *Surinder Singh Versus Darshan Kaur*, is withdrawn from the Court of learned District Judge, Ludhiana, and same is transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Moga, who may retain the case himself or entrust

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the same to any other Court of competent jurisdiction. Consequently, instant petition is allowed.
